B.A.T. Boys Automotive was founded in 2006 by Buzz McQueen and was recently expanded into its new facility. When construction began, they emphasized their desire to present an aesthetically pleasing property and building for customers to enjoy. Completed in September 2016, the landscape enhancements stretched far beyond minimum requirements, exhibiting their commitment to the community as well as their business and its customers.

The City of Branson Tree Board applauds the efforts of this business to make these improvements and is pleased to present the June 2017 Beautification Award to B.A.T. Boys Automotive.

The City of Branson presents the Beautification Awards monthly through October, and selects award recipients from nominations submitted on behalf of deserving commercial properties in Branson by the recurring deadline of the 20th of each month. The criteria for nominations are as follows:

- A commercial property located within the city limits
- Landscaped area(s) must be visible to the public

All nominations are reviewed and winners selected by the Tree Board on a monthly basis. Winners receive a certificate and a sign to showcase at their property. In addition to the publicity of the award, winners will also receive a certificate and a sign placed on their property showcasing it as the Beautification Winner of that Month.
